



# TRAVEL CHECKLIST

## Travel Documents & Identification

- ❑ Make sure you have an updated Passport!
  - ❑ If you need to update your name, or your passport expires within 6 months of your sailing return date, be sure to get your passport renewed!
  - ❑ If you've never had a passport before, make sure to turn in your Passport Application as soon as possible. It can take several months to receive your passport!
- ❑ Airline Tickets (or e-ticket confirmation)
- ❑ Cruise Documents
- ❑ Valid Driver's License
- ❑ Auto Insurance Card (Incase you decide to rent a car during your trip)
- ❑ Medical Insurance Cards
- ❑ Credit/Debit Cards (Be sure to notify your credit card/debit card company before your trip to let them know you will be traveling outside your normal areas)
- ❑ Cash or Traveler's Check
- ❑ Several copies of your airline tickets, cruise tickets, passport, & itinerary (Pack 1 copy of each in your carry-on, checked luggage and leave one with someone at home)
- ❑ Contact Numbers to report lost/stolen credit/debit cards or traveler's checks
- ❑ Emergency Contact Numbers

## Clothing

- ❑ Clothing you can layer (Long sleeve shirts, fleece jackets, sweaters, water-resistant windbreaker jacket)
- ❑ Comfortable Shoes (with good traction if you plan to go on a hiking excursion), sandals (for poolside), Tennis shoes, dressy shoes for dinner
- ❑ Warm Pants, Jeans



- Wool Socks (These are the best for keeping your feet warm!) & Cotton Socks
- Light winter gloves, scarf, & hat
- Summer Clothing (Short sleeve shirts, & shorts)
- 2 Swimsuits
- Fitness Outfit and Tennis Shoes (If you choose to use the Fitness Facilities)
- Underwear and bras
- 4 Casual Outfits, 1 Smart Casual Outfit and 2 Formal Outfits for Dinner
  - Casual Outfit Examples: sport shirt & slacks for men; sundresses or pants for women
  - Smart Casual Examples: jackets & ties for men; dresses or pantsuits for women
  - Formal Examples: Suits & ties or tuxedos for men; cocktail dresses for women

## Toiletries

- Sunscreen, SPF Chapstick
- Mosquito Repellant
- Small First Aid Kit
- Makeup, makeup remover, face lotion
- Razor, shaving cream, deodorant
- Perfume or cologne
- Brush & Comb
- Hairdryer, curling iron and/or flat iron
- Hair ties & bobby pins
- Hair gel, hair spray
- Shampoo/Conditioner, Body Wash
- Body Lotion
- Aloe Vera (Incase you get a sunburn)
- Hand Sanitizer/ Hand Wipes
- Medications, Tylenol, Ibuprofen, Dramamine

## Electronics

- ❑ Cell Phone & Charger
- ❑ Portable External Phone Charger
  - ❑ (Comes in handy during your excursions when you can't locate an outlet to charge your phone).
- ❑ Digital Camera
- ❑ SD Cards
- ❑ Video Camera
- ❑ Tripod
- ❑ Extra Batteries or Battery Charger for your devices
- ❑ MP3 Player, iPod, & earphones
- ❑ Laptop or Tablet

## Misc.

- ❑ Binoculars
- ❑ Sunglasses
- ❑ Backpack or tote bag
- ❑ Zipper Top Bags
  - ❑ (Freezer-size zipper-top bags are perfect for keeping your clothing folded and toiletries separated (in case of unforeseen leaks). Organizing your clothing into separate baggies make it easier to repack in case your luggage is searched. Bring extra bags for storing dirty or damp clothing.)
- ❑ Watch or Alarm Clock
- ❑ Lanyard with a plastic sleeve to hold your roomkey
- ❑ Portable Umbrella
- ❑ Hand Warmers
- ❑ Reading Material
  - ❑ Bring some magazines or books to catch up on during your vacation!

## What to Leave at Home:

Weapons, illegal drugs, \*\*alcoholic & non-alcoholic beverages, flammable liquids (including lighter fluid & fireworks), explosives, dangerous chemicals (including bleach and paint), firearms & ammunition (including realistic replicas), \*sharp objects (including knives and scissors), candles & incense, coffee makers, clothes irons, hot plates, baseball bats, hockey sticks, cricket bats, bows & arrows, skateboards, surfboards, martial arts gear, self-defense gear (including handcuffs, pepper spray and nightsticks), HAM radios, electrical extension cords, and anything else that may interfere with the safe operation of the ship or the safe and secure environment of the guests and crew.

\*Personal grooming items such as safety razors are allowed. Scissors with a blade length less than 4 inches are allowed.

\*\*Alcoholic beverages that are purchased in ports-of-call or from shops onboard will be stored by the ship & delivered to you on the last day of sailing. Alcoholic beverages seized on embarkation day will not be returned.
